President's Message

Three months ago I was involved in a near fatal motor vehicle accident. Being in the smaller vehicle, I was violently spun off the road and head-first into the ditch by a much larger vehicle. It was God's will that I alternated between consciousness and unconsciousness for the next ~9 days until I began the journey back to health and hopefully a full recovery. Why was I given the chance to have glimpses of my ordeal as I struggled to survive such a serious accident? I hope sharing my perspective of these events is one reason.

I did not see the truck coming as it hit me from the side and propelled me to a stand-still in the ditch. I did see the actions of many pro-life people over the next ~9 days and the ~3 months since. People involved in the accident immediately called 911. First responders all arrived within 40 minutes of the accident and did an admirable job of attending to my needs. Being conscious, I was aware that I had a broken left leg and broken upper right arm. Being in shock, I respect that

the emergency personnel had to take precautions that my self-diagnosis of my injuries might be in error and other matters like sore ribs and difficulty breathing might be signs of more serious internal injuries. Looking back, I must admire that trained professionals who really care about life were readily available to spring into action that day on my behalf and also on your behalf if you need them.

This accident scene involved at least one of each of the following first responder vehicles: fire truck, police car, ambulance, family members, and STARS helicopter. Jointly they assessed my condition and then coordinated matters to correctly decide that I be given the 12 minute helicopter ride to Foothills hospital in Calgary while trained medical professionals were attending to my injuries. Upon arrival at Foothills, other doctors, nurses, and technicians took over to perform necessary diagnostic testing to ensure that I was able to endure the 4+ hours of surgery that was required to operate on my broken leg and arm.

The next ~8 days of hospitalization was not pleasant as I was a trauma patient being fed intravenously and treated for the dreaded C-deficile intestinal infection that is often contracted by trauma patients. Again I marvel at the health care I received as many pro-life professionals were there for me and they will be there for you if you need them.

On day 9, I awoke to a group of health professionals who were talking about my condition and I declared that I was starving and would like something to eat if possible. This was music to the ears of the nurse who responded .../2

that I could eat whatever I wanted. I asked for a bag of salt and vinegar chips my son had brought and indulged in this medicinal meal that I jokingly declare saved my life as I have been quickly recovering ever since.

After extolling the efforts of our medical professionals, I must also extol the virtues of many other pro-life people who supported my recovery by their prayers. People of faith, including me, will say that God's holy angels were looking out for me that beautiful day. The car picture shows the violence of the collision and leaves

us to ponder the state of a person inside. I am truly humbled by the many people who have told me they were praying for me.

I consider humility to be a synonym for the word faith and so my faith was being strengthened by the response of those who were praying. Being a Catholic, I was given last rites (sacrament of the sick) before going in for



surgery. Masses were being offered for me by many caring friends and clergy. The Blessed Mother Mary was invoked by many who share a devotion to her rosary as I do. If you were to experience a near fatal accident as I did, I hope that I could be part of a faith-filled community that would come to your aid.

> Being given a chance to journey on in life, I have a greater awareness of my limitations as a human being. I am more aware of my need for God and others in my future decisions. I have been blessed to live to share this with you. Hopefully this sharing will help you to ponder your future decisions and invite our great God into your life. How blessed

we are when we see ourselves as the pro-life people we truly are!!!

The Hike for Life Supports Life Education in Schools... Now what?

Covid-19 has affected the operation of schools at this time. After contacting the Calgary Catholic and Christ the Redeemer school boards, it has been confirmed that no outside speakers (except Alberta Health Services) are to be invited to the schools until the New Year 2021. Consequently booked presentations in September and October have been postponed.

We are creating posters and banners that can be used at future educational pro-life events, as well as in churches and schools, to continue exposure to how we'live pro-life' in our day-to-day lives. Our messages aim to say, "We are pro-life when we: accept and respect the gift of all human life from conception until natural death; feed the hungry; give drink to the thirsty; clothe the naked; shelter the homeless; visit and care for the sick, vulnerable, and elderly; visit the imprisoned; and bury the dead."

The virtual pastoral lay associations bi-annual meeting with Fr. Adrian Martens and Fr. Wilbert Chin Jon, VG on September 26 via the online Zoom platform included inspiring presentations about how to continue ministry during the pandemic. They shared principles and examples of ministry to all people. We heard, "Mercy has to be the main identifier of a Christian; and if we are not for others, we are not for God; our ministry is in the world." We learned that devotion sustains our faith until we can celebrate together again; Christian action includes charitable acts. Many are suffering, and when we are suffering, we must remember that others are as well. We can be present. We must do something, and prayer is huge! It was an excellent presentation.

Thomas Bouchard from the Calgary Catholic Medical Assn. explained that we are at a time during the pandemic




when people are asking, "What proof do we have that wearing a mask works to prevent covid-19?" Dr. Bouchard said that people always want proofs and results. But this is secondary, as our primary question must be: "How can I be of service to my neighbour, how can I be prudent and charitable to others?" When charity and prudence are first, the practical proofs and results follow.

Until schools allow us to be invited to give presentations in classroom again, we continue to maintain running of the office by updating our records and reports for the upcoming AGM.
